A new link called "Outpatient Consults" shows all your pending consults; it does not list consults that have been resulted as those are also now available on the patient page. Consults can be manually entered, drafts saved for later work, or electronically signed within the web browser. Clinics that are willing to make 100% of their SPEC slots available in Easy can now just call Kim Pham @ 2-5007....no more "EASY" in the comment field. Optometry is the first clinic to do so....CONGRATS and THANK YOU! For those of you that are curious, the barcode links are for a medication/blood product barcoding pilot underway in the NICU. We hope to have wireless handheld barcode scanners throughout the hospital by '04.

Remember you can access Easy-CHCS from home using a dial-in Shiva account (call 2-5600 to setup an account) or by cable/DSL at <https://nmcsd-gate.med.navy.mil>. Please note the "s" in "https".

1) Headaches with abnormal neurological exam

2) Headaches associated with complex symptoms (i.e., blindness, Hemiparesis, etc.)

3) Failure to respond to one trial of prophylactic treatment (i.e., betablockers, tricyclic antidepressants, anticonvulsants, calcium channel blockers, etc.) for at least six weeks.

4) Impairment for fitness for duty (i.e., disabling headaches, intolerable medication side effects, etc.)

5) Rebound headaches (i.e., refractory/dependent of non-narcotic/narcotic analgesics, etc.)

Neuro Consult - Should Include

+1) Relevant findings in the physical and neurological examination.

2) Relevant diagnostic test results.

3) Therapeutic trails (i.e., list of medications for headaches, etc) including doses and durations.
