Free Download - Uncertified

- Non-production software intended for evaluation
- No support
- Cross-platform software consisting of:
 - Routines
 - Globals
 - Patches
- Demo compilation(s) "Appliance" and/or Live CD



WorldVistA EHR - Fee Based

- Certified version
- Support services
- Packaged software



Certified Version

- Unique number/id for each end user organization
- Written agreement
- Proposed "\$300/year per end user organization"



Certification Agreement

- To comply with terms of CCHIT certification
- Scope
 - Updates and bug fixes
 - Modifications
 - Add-ons
 - Use of certification seal



Support Services

Update distribution

- Assistance contract or time and materials
- Subscription based "aggregated updates" yearly fee
- Subscription based "semi-auto updates" yearly fee

Upgrade service

- Upgrading implementations to current update level
- Upgrading implementations to "certified" version
- Contract or time and materials

Packaged Software

- GT.M or Cache ready version "uncertified"
- Add-ons
 - CPT codes
 - Zip codes
 - Formulary ...
- Add-ons bundled
- Custom packaging



Training and Education
