Mission

Facilitate economic development, strategic alliances, and training programs as a focal point for emerging technology sustainment issues



Goals

- Foster interdisciplinary collaboration for large-scale, and highly collaborative projects that cannot readily be accomplished within the traditional setting of a small business
- Build a culture where a group of staff with interdisciplinary skills collaborate to develop common methodologies and solutions in research and business proposals and solutions
- Build teams among companies and organizations that have demonstrated qualifications to apply for grants and contrac proposals



Hui and Consortium Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA)

- Develop, test and disseminate modifications, enhancements and new developments to promote useful, efficient and sustainable EHRs
- Provide access and use to the Hui's ASP data center and other resources to support research, development and testing of new developments
- Define new research and development projects to support program goals including facilitating interoperability among health information providers
- Foster partnerships with institutions and organizations to jointly research and develop new applications and programs



Hawaii Consortium Projects

- Integrated VA FOIA patches to upgrade Hui OpenVista v4.1
- Facilitated standing up a Hui OpenVista ASP system for HP Malaysia
- Developed a Hui OpenVista Level 1 course for SAs and CACs and conducted the course under contract to HP Malaysia
- Executing Hui's FY'08 \$1.9M Clinical Informatics Research Program
 - Develop operational protocols and technologies to implement a Health Information Exchange to achieve interoperability
 - Study the outcomes of an EHR in facilitating traumatic brain injury (TBI) rehabilitation
 - Research based on the theme of personalized health care



HMSA HI-IQ Grant Program Blue Cross Blue Shield

- \$30M to fund innovative ideas to improve patient care and outcome
- \$20M to buy electronic medical record systems* for the association's member physicians

*CCHIT certification a requirement



Projects in Hawaii

- Completing a Hui research project to install Hui OpenVista in two rural hospitals and three clinics on Kauai (\$2.5M)
- Implementing a Hui research grant to study the impact of an open source integrated EHR system on adverse drug effects in a rural community (\$3M)
- TipG implementing OpenVista in 4-6 rural clinics (\$3.1M CMS grant)
- TipG providing additional infrastructure and systems interfaces to Hui OpenVista for the Kauai implementations (\$1.6M HRSA grant)



Projects in Hawaii

• Upgrade the State of Hawaii Telehealth Access Network (STAN) to HD (\$4.8M FCC grant). STAN interconnects 45 hospitals, clinics, and academic sites throughout the Pacific region in a dedicated network
