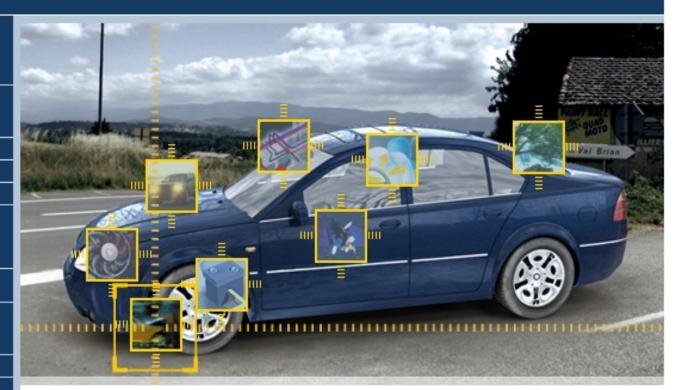

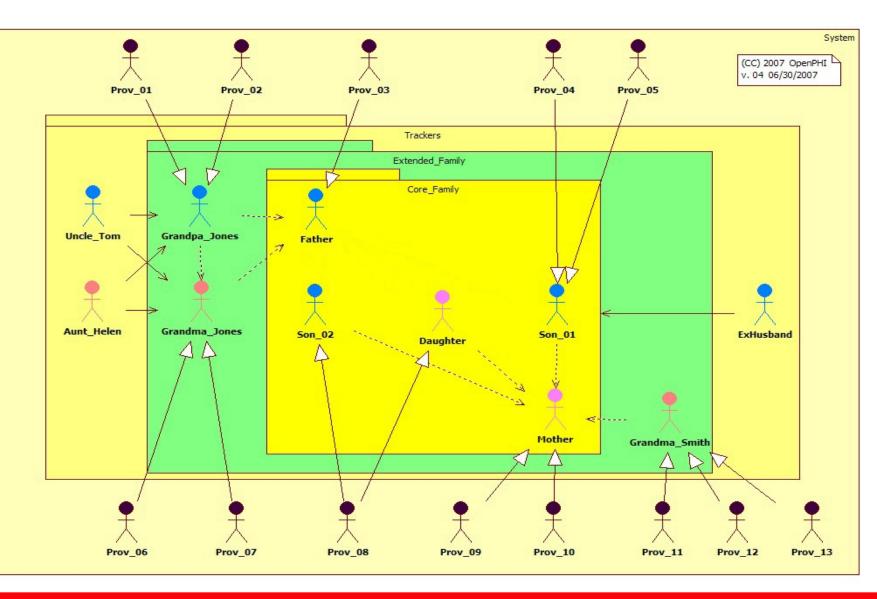
Why Personalized Health Informatics?

Consumers want control over health data: social and economic pressure

- less trust in providers
- need to improve healthcare's delivery systems, methods
- consumer-driven healthcare (HSAs)
- high-deductible plans
- care coordination for life-long chronic diseases

- Consumers pushed to "own" their health data:
 - few EMR deployments
 - privacy of outsourced health data processing
 - health data floating around (RHIOs) with no Consumer control
- Need to migrate from a provider-centric model towards a Consumercontrolled model of health improvement.

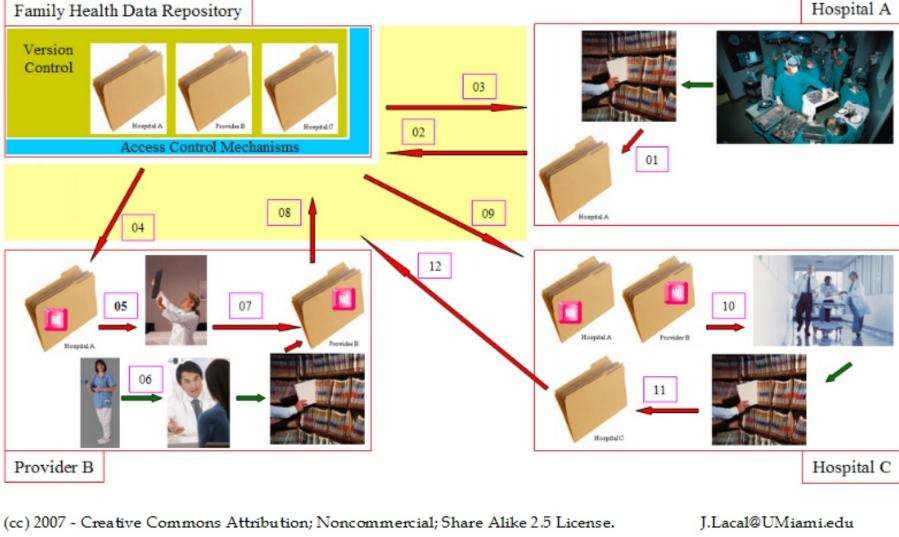

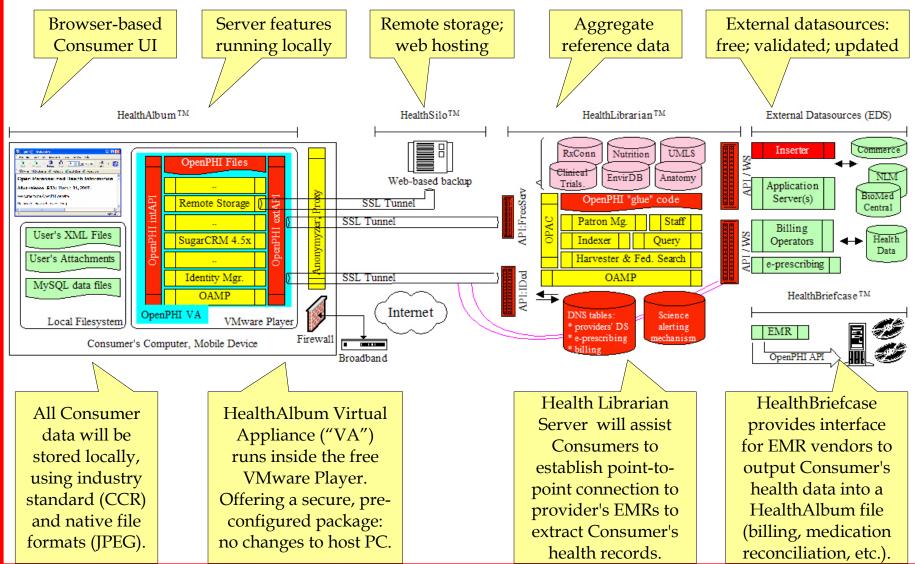
Consumer-Owned Health Data Ecosystem

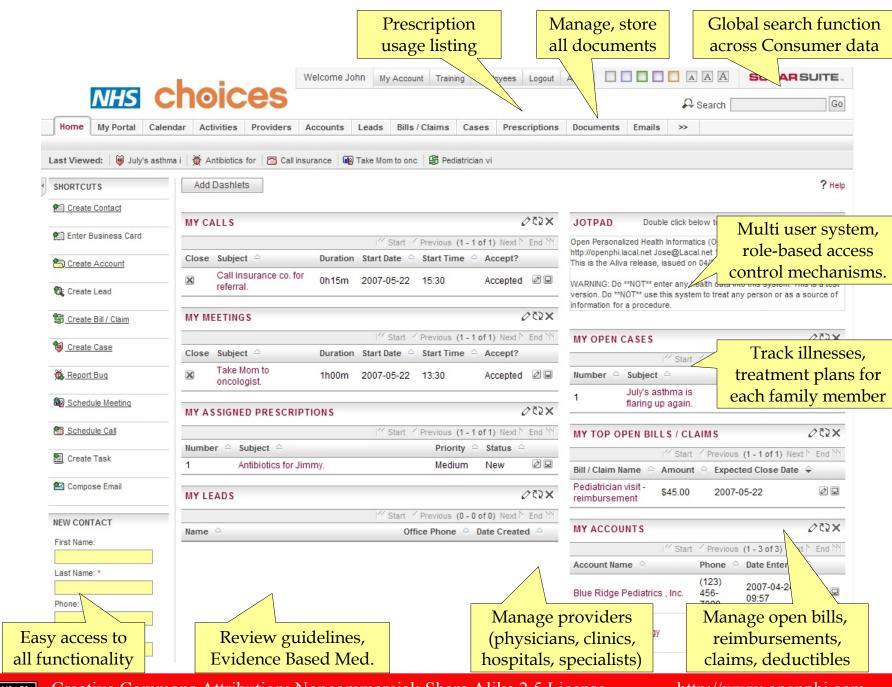

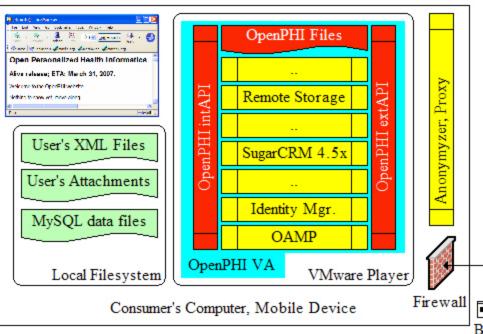

- web browser interface
- Consumer data is also stored locally
- runs on older PCs
- multiple languages

- a.) HIPAA Compliance
- b.) Medication Reconciliation

- **EMR Vendors' Must:**
- a.) Customers' Looking for lower/no Vendor Lock
- **b.) CCHIT Certification**

c.) Liability Reduction

JCAHO – Medication Reconciliation

"Reconciliation is the process of comparing what medication the patient is taking at the time of admission or entry to a new setting or level of care, with what the organization is providing (admission or new medication orders) to avoid errors such as conflicts or unintentional omissions."

JCAHO's National Patient Safety Goals for 2007, which includes #08a:

"The complete list of medications is also provided to the patient on discharge from the facility."

Liability Reduction

HealthAlbum[™] Usage:

- provide electronic copy of all data collected during treatment / stay
- data visibility reduces anxiety, doubts

Item 22:

"The system shall provide templates for displaying medical summary data in a structured format" "Examples might include the continuity of care record or the CDA. This requirement does not specify a particular format although many vendors will choose to use the harmonized CCR/CDA/CRS once available."

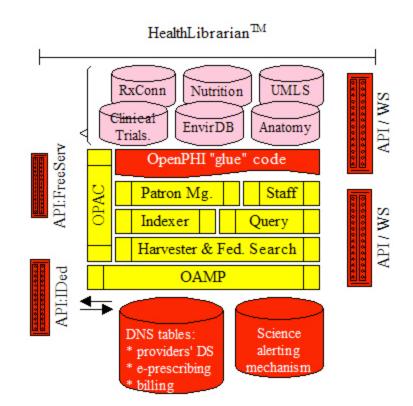

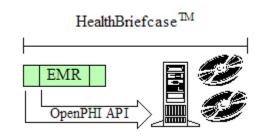
HealthBriefcase[™]
