PHR design principles.

- Interoperability.
- Based on MyHealtheVet.



Provides a web-based portal for patients to review and contribute to their medical information.

Portable:

Medical information can be accessed at any location and shared with providers, specialists, and more.

Interactive:

Patients may contribute information which may benefit their care, such as blood glucose or pressure, and share information with providers.

Efficient:

Better information quality and exchange can result in improved and proactive care, as well as cost savings.

PHR Project Status



In Pilot:

- Clay County, West Virginia location running.
- Approx 700 patients enrolled.
- Web-enabled.
- Accessible through on-site kiosk.
- Ongoing support and improvement.

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Medical Events:

Visiting the doctor, getting surgery, disease treatments.

Allergies and Reactions:

Important in medical encounters and life-threatening situations.

Medications:

Providers can review prescription strengths and drug interactions.

Lab and Test Results:

Interpretable, user-friendly results promote usability and communication.

Vitals Measurement:

Baseline indicators of overall health for better diagnoses and general health management.

Immunizations:

Track expiration and delinquency of immunizations for general health and relevance to diagnoses.

Health Calendar:

Manage upcoming appointments, and keep on track with care plans.

“Meaningful Use” satisfaction


Assists in satisfying patient communication requirements.
