



## **MSC Fileman 22.2 Remediation**

#### Critical license issue

- Mixed GPL and Apache Licensing
- Code used to begin gap analysis

#### Joint MSC/VEN/OSEHRA Agreement

- MSC relicensed under Apache 2.0
- VEN merged FLAP changes into latest version of MSC Fileman (1051)

#### OSEHRA Coordination and Funding

- Briefing for VA stakeholders
- Funded and managed remediation
- Delivered new code base on Jan 6
- MSC Fileman 22.2 will anchor code alignment



### **Code Convergence Effort**

- Effort by OSEHRA Corporate Members to establish base of aligned code
- Kickoff Meeting 19-21 November 2014
  - Oakland, CA
  - Members and SMEs
  - Open Community Briefing Call on Final Day
- Sprints defined as part of kickoff
- Some impact from MSC Fileman effort

  - Cross-Platform Compatibility
  - Kernel Toolkit
  - Mailman
- Testing Tools
- Terminology and Master File Updates
- Meaningful Use
- Pharmacy (including MOCHA adoption)
- PIV Card & Other 2-Factor Authentication



These items are in scope for the May 2015 phase:

- Identification of packages with few divergences, for accelerated reconciliation
- Development of adaptive strategy for MOCHA
- Convergence of RPC and M-to-M brokers across VistA distributions
- Improvement of SAC compliance warnings in XINDEX

### **Open Source EHR Microsite**

- Conceived to promote open source EHR solution independent of branding
- Funded by member contributions
- www.osehr.org (just drop the "a"...)
- Part of an ongoing campaign to raise awareness of the open source EHR alternative



#### **OSEHRA Forum**

- Essential to product management of OSEHRA VistA
- Improved (open source) version of VA Forum
- Capable of managing multiple patch streams
- Targeted for Q2 2015



### **MOCHA Advocacy**

- Representing community concern and interests
- Unilateral VA action with significant community impact
- Working to identify and certify an open source adapter solution
- Also working larger cultural issue with VA and other community members



#### **ANSI Standard for Software Quality**

- OSEHRA in last stage of accreditation process
  - One-month mandatory ballot
- Will be forming Standards Work Group
  - Membership will be open
  - Responsible for preparation of draft standard
- Goal: Standard for quality of open source healthcare software by June 2015
